



window of your choice.



The insulation value is an all-important attribute.

The insulation value of a sectional garage door outshines that of a standard swing-up door any day. L-Door can provide you with sandwich panels, filled with a polyurethane-foam layer of no less than 42 mm in thickness which not only enhances the durability and the strength of your door but also results in a high insulation value and, accordingly, a significant reduction in your energy bills. The rubber sealing strips between the panels, on the sides and at the top and bottom of your door ensure that cold and dampness are kept outside. At L-Door, the nose/groove and the front of the panel are made of one and the same plate, which further adds to the panel's strength.



Extra space... Now, there's a bonus


Aside from comfort, durability, insulation and safety, the extra space you stand to gain, or rather, the amount of space you won't be losing out on by opting for a sectional door, is not to be underestimated. Because the door is subdivided into sections, the amount of garage space you lose is negligible, since the door does not swing out as it opens. This has the advantage that you don't lose any useful space on your footpath or drive and that you can park your car right up to your garage door.




Panel types

To cater for all circumstances, L-Door stocks two types of rail systems.


G200

Hardware system G200 requires a clear overhead space of 200 mm. Our rail systems exclusively come with galvanised and powder-coated torsion springs, which in the case of the G200, are located above your sectional garage door.



G100 / R60

For garages with limited installation height, L-Door has developed the G100 hardware system. This rail system merely requires an installation height of 80 mm in the first stroke above the clear width and reduces to 50 mm in the second stroke. In our G100 rail system, the torsion springs are located at the end of the horizontal rails. Hardware system R60 with a straight rail is used for garage doors in the Nature Line and Puma Line ranges.



VA Isolator, rubber for extra insulation



This innovation is based on the principle of air retention because stagnant air is an excellent insulator in itself. The VA Isolator prevents 'thermal bridging' and has excellent soundproofing properties. This is available as an optional extra.


The patented Smart-Connection® is the connection between the horizontal and the vertical rails. This innovative solution ensures that your sectional door opens and closes almost noiselessly and is less prone to wear and tear.



Aluminium bend

The hardware system uses an aluminium bend as standard. This high-grade material ensures a perfect fit and prevents premature wear and tear.

The top rails are moulded from one piece to minimise noise during opening and closing.



V-shaped rails

The rails have a V shape so that the ball-bearing bearing rollers in the rails are guaranteed to run smoothly and stably which will boost to their lifespan no end.



Powder-coated torsion springs

The torsion springs of your sectional garage door are always made to size, in function of the dimensions and weight of your door. They ensure that the door leaf is always perfectly counterbalanced. L-Door torsion springs are invariably given a silver-grey powder-coated finish as this extends their lifespan by no less than 40%.




Safety

When changing your garage door, safety will of course be one of your main considerations. This is why L-Door sectional doors always come with the most important safety features. Depending on user requirements, further safety features can be added.

Standard safety features

- The finger guard ensures that there is no way that fingers can get trapped between the door's panels.
- The spring break device prevents the garage from going into free fall in the unlikely event one of the springs was to break.
- Obstruction sensor: if you opt for an automated garage door, the door will stop automatically as soon as the closing door comes into contact with an object.




Additional safety features

- Photocell sensor: an invisible infrared beam fitted to the bottom of the door which will reverse the door's closing movement as soon as the beam is broken.
- Emergency release: uncouples the garage door from the outside without having to rely on the motor.
 An excellent feature if your automated garage door is the only means of access to your garage.



 Motion sensor: thanks to the L-Door light curtains the detection field within the clear width of your sectional door is expanded considerably, with the result that absolutely everything is detected, from playing children up to and including your new car.







Maintenance

When purchasing an L-Door door you opt for a top-quality bespoke Belgian product. Even long after your door has been fitted you can continue to rely on L-Door to maximise your garage door's lifespan.

A sectional door, just like your car, consists of mechanical components. Even though we use top-quality materials and pride ourselves on stringent quality control, we would still recommend that you have your door serviced periodically.

In most cases, everything will be functioning as it should and the service will basically involve greasing. An annual service will considerable extend your door's lifespan.

What does preventative maintenance entail?

- A thorough inspection, including adjustment, of your sectional door and springs;
- Lubricating your door;
- A rigorous inspection of the steel cables:
- Checking and inspecting the various safety features;
- Checking the motor (where applicable);
- Replacing any parts that have been damaged.


Our Section Line sectional doors are constructed from anti-finger trap sandwich panels, consisting of a doublewalled galvanised steel plate filled with polyurethane by means of a continuous lamination process. Polyurethane (PUR) does not contain any hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), hydrochlorofluocarbons (HCFCs), has nil ozone depletion potential (ODP), which makes it fully consistent with the Montreal and Kyoto Protocols, and guarantees a homogeneous cell structure and solid bond. The steel sheeting has a thickness of 0.58 mm (DIN 4102) Rubber sealing profiles are fitted both around and in between the door panels

so that heat transmission is reduced to a minimum (U value panel = 0.37 W/m²/K). The guide system is fully galvanised and is re-adjustable. The bearing rollers have a nylon running surface (noiseless and wear-resistant) and have been fitted with dust-proof, self-lubricating

All our ST1/ST2/ST3/ST4/ST5/ST9/ST10/ST15/ST17/ ST18/ST19/ ST21/STF door types are enamelled in RAL 9010 (pure white) to a thickness of 25 micron as standard. Subject to a surcharge, all our doors can either be foil-clad or lacquered in any colour of your choice.




U value or thermal performance of an L-Door sectional door

A sectional door's heat transmission is calculated on the basis of the EN13241-1:2003 + A1:20011 Standard (Industrial, commercial and garage doors and gates) and underlying Standards EN12428 and EN10077- 2 (Thermal performance of windows, doors and shutters - calculation of thermal transmittance).

The U value of a sectional door always relates to the door leaf as a whole, the rubber seals and the rail fittings.

Generally speaking, an average door has a U value of 1.0 W/m²K if it does not have any windows and a U value ranging between 1.4 W/m²K and 1.8 W/m²K if it does. In any event, the U value of a sectional door from the Section Line range is invariably below the maximum permissible U value of 2.0 W/m²K as specified in the EPB standards drawn up by the Flemish Energy Agency.


